






- What does it require for <u>me</u> as a school employee?
 - <u>Any</u> school employee who learns of sex discrimination, sexual harassment, or sexual misconduct must <u>immediately notify the</u> <u>appropriate school officials</u>.
 - Includes conduct between:
 - Student (student-to-student)
 - Employees (employee-to-employee)
 - Students and Employees (employee-to-student, student-to-employee)

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


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WHAT SHOULD I DO?
